**FINAL PENSION PAYMENTS:**

Sidney Kindler died on 11/6/10. He retired in 1996. Due to his beneficiary, his son, will be a final payment for the 6 days pension for November.

Bruce Gauvain died on 11/14/10. He retired on 7/28/03 from LHA. Due to his beneficiary, his daughter Jennifer will be a final payment for the 14 days pension for November.

**Section 27 and 28 of Chapter 131 of the Acts of 2010** (Tabled at last month's meeting)

Establishes a local option to increase the annual survivor benefit received under **Section 101 from \$6000 to \$9000**. The eligible people were survivors of disability pensioners who retired before Option C became available. There are 44 survivors receiving Section 101 benefits and the total increase would amount to \$3,903.95 per month. The City Council would also have to approve this local option. The increase could not be implemented before January 1, 2011, but could be voted on and accepted by the City Council at any time.
