The Lynn Economic Development & Industrial Corporation has received a grant from the Massachusetts Office of Coastal Zone Management to prepare a Coastal Resiliency Assessment and Adaptation Plan that evaluates the vulnerability of coastal infrastructure and resources, and lays the groundwork for planning strategies to adapt to future climate change conditions. The second of three public meetings will be held on Tuesday, March 29, 2016 from 5:30 to 7:00 in the Council Chambers at Lynn City Hall. Overall project goals and objectives will be presented, and climate change scenarios to be evaluated will be presented and reviewed. Potential coastal flooding under future sea level rise and storm scenarios will form the basis for planning to increase the resiliency of Lynn's coastline.
