## Answers to your questions

If your trash was missed or to report damaged containers, contact the DPW from 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. at 781-268-8000. Do not place any of the following in your trash: non-empty aerosol cans, appliances, automotive batteries, chemical containers, construction debris, leaf and yard waste, flat-screen TVs or CRT monitors. For bulky materials, or to lease additional trash or recycle containers, contact WM at 1-800-972-4545. Compost bins are available at the DPW for \$50.

### Helpful hints

- ▲ For containers to be recycled, please rinse, and remove corks, rings and wraps and flatten all cardboard.
- ▲ Trash overflow bags (purple) vendor list available at [lynnma.gov](http://lynnma.gov).
- ▲ Items for waste collection or donations for pick-up cannot be placed upon the ground.
- ▲ Street sweeping will be held in the spring and fall. Check [lynnma.gov](http://lynnma.gov) for schedule and more information.
- ▲ Snow emergency and removal information can be found on [lynnma.gov](http://lynnma.gov).
- ▲ Needles must be in a rigid container. Return to City Hall, 1st floor. No loose needles.
- ▲ For furniture to be picked up curbside by WM, the cost will be \$25.30 per item. Residents must call WM at 1-800-972-4545.

The DPW office, located at 250 Commercial St., is open Monday, Wednesday and Thursday, 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.; Tuesday, 8:30 a.m. to 8 p.m.; and Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

The following services are for Lynn residents only. ID required.

#### Computer monitors, TVs, propane tanks

Computer monitors, TVs and propane tanks can be dropped off at 250 Commercial St. Monday through Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. There is a \$25 charge for monitors and TVs, \$5 for propane tanks.

#### Leaf and yard waste pickup

Leaf and yard waste may be dropped off every Saturday from April 9, 2022 through Saturday, December 17, 2022. You may place yard waste curb-side on your regular trash day by 7 a.m., the weeks of 9/19/22, 10/10/22, 10/24/22, 11/7/22, 11/14/22, 11/21/22, 12/5/22, 1/9/23, 4/10/23 and 5/15/23. Leaves, grass and other materials should be placed in barrels or paper leaf bags.

#### Bulky Item Days

The DPW will hold Bulky Item days for large items and fluorescent light bulbs at Covanta, 247 Commercial St., Lynn, MA. 01905, on 7/16/22, 8/13/22, 9/17/22, 10/22/22, 11/19/22, 1/7/23, 4/15/23,

5/13/23 and 6/17/23 from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. No appliances, construction material or wood. Driver licenses must be presented. No commercial vehicles nor U-Haul trucks allowed.

Fluorescent light bulbs may also be dropped off at the DPW, 250 Commercial St., Monday through Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

#### Hazardous Waste

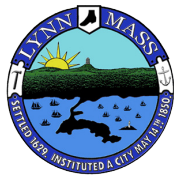
Hazardous waste may be dropped off at 250 Commercial St., on 8/27/22, 10/15/22 and 5/20/23 from 8 a.m. to noon. Payment required.

#### Christmas tree/leaf and yard waste pickup

Christmas tree and leaf and yard waste pickup will be Jan. 9-13, 2023.

#### Snow Emergency

During the winter months, Snow Emergency parking bans may be announced through various communication outlets and indicated by the blue lights around the city. # Recycling and waste helpful hints

## Purple Overflow Bags

**Don't forget to purchase extra purple bags for additional trash during the holiday season!**

Use this bag for overflow trash only.  
You must always use your automated refuse container.  
Use overflow bags for excessive trash weeks.

*No yard waste | No recyclables | No construction debris | No hazardous waste  
Must place bag on top of the container*

## Mattress Recycling Program

**The City received a 1 year grant through Massachusetts Dept. of Environmental Protection.**

Residents can bring their mattress and box springs to the DPW for drop-off. There will be a collection fee for \$20 for the first year; after the grant funds are depleted, it will be a \$20 fee for each item.

The collection container will be available 8:30 a.m. - 2:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8:30 a.m. - noon on Friday.

Residents will be responsible to load mattresses in the container vertically. Residents will still be able to call Waste Management for curbside pickup as long as there is no waste ban.

Unacceptable mattresses (very wet, moldy, infested with bed bugs) will be put aside for trash.

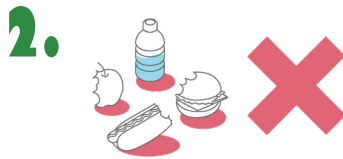
<i>Component</i>	<i>End use</i>
Box springs & steel inner-springs	Often made with recycled scrap steel, can be recycled into new steel
Mattress foam	May be ground up, mixed with binders and formed into carpet padding or cushions
Fabric & Fibers	Fibers found in mattresses can be recycled into industrial filters or padding
Box spring foundation wood	Wood may be chipped and used as animal bedding, mulch or biomass fuel

## Remember these three rules to recycle right

Knowing these rules and putting them into practice during your recycling journey will help you to recycle more efficiently. And it will help to ensure everything that makes it into your bin finds a second life.



1. Recycle clean bottles, cans, paper and cardboard.



2. Keep food and liquid out of your recycling.

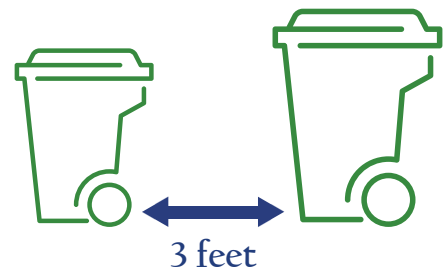


3. No loose plastic bags and no bagged recyclables.

## Did you know?

**Trash and recycle carts should be placed 3 feet apart when placed at the curb.**

Damaged trash and recycle carts and parts can be replaced, including:  
Missing or cracked lids  
Missing or broken wheels  
Cracked trash/recycle carts

Los colchones inaceptables (muy húmedos, mohosos, infestados con chinches) se dejarán de lado para la basura.

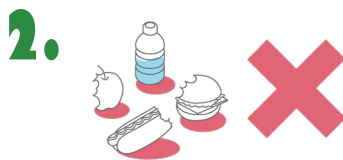
Componente	Uso final
Caja fundacion de acero interno	A menudo hecho con acero reciclado de chatarra, se puede reciclar en acero nuevo
Colchón espuma	Puede ser fundido, mezclado con aglutinantes y se forma en relleno de alfombras o cojines
Fibras y tela	Las fibras encontradas en los colchones se pueden reciclar en filtros industriales o relleno
Caja Fundación de primavera madera	La madera puede estar astillada y utilizada como ropa de cama de animales, mantillo o combustible de biomasa

## Recuerde estas tres reglas para reciclar correctamente

Conocer estas reglas y ponerlas en práctica durante su reciclaje lo ayudará a reciclar de manera más eficiente. Y ayudará a garantizar que todo lo que haga en su contenedor encuentra una segunda vida.



Recicle las botellas limpias, latas, papel y cartón.



Mantenga la comida y el líquido fuera de su reciclaje.



No hay bolsas de plástico sueltas y sin reciclables embolsados.

## Sabias?

Los contenidos de basura y reciclaje deben colocarse a 3 pies de distancia cuando se colocan en el bordillo.

Los carros de basura y reciclaje dañados pueden ser reemplazados, incluyendo:  
Llantas faltantes o agrietadas  
Ruedas faltantes o rotas  
Carreras de basura agrietada/reciclaje
