IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY TWO AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR PERSON OR PERSONS ACTIVATING POLICE AND FIRE SECURITY ALARM SYSTEMS WITHOUT GROUNDS OR BASIS.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Lynn and by the authority of the same as follows, to wit

<u>SECTION 1.</u> An Ordinance establishing penalties for person or persons activating privately owned police and fire security alarm systems without grounds or bas is , is hereby established.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Any person or persons within any calendar year, activating, or causing to be activated any police or fire security alarm systems privately owned and connected to a City of Lynn police or fire station for any reason not found to be based upon need of the services of the responding police or fire personnel shall be fined as follows:

- a. For the first two (2) unbased responses there shall be no fines.
- b. For the third (3rd) unbased response, there shall be a fine of Twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars
- c. For the fourth (4th) unbased response, there shall be a fine of Fifty (\$50.00) dollars.
- d. For the fifth (5th), and any other, unbased response, there shall be a fine of One Hundred (\$100.00) dollars.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty-one (31) days after its final approval.
