Ice Removal regulations



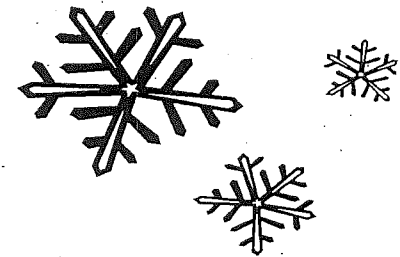
BUSINESS AND COMMERCIAL PROPERTY OWNERS

- * SNOW MUST BE REMOVED BETWEEN SUNRISE AND SUNSET, WITHIN 3 HOURS AFTER THE SNOW HAS STOPPED FALLING.
- * A CLEAR, FULL, PAVED PATH THE WIDTH OF THE SIDEWALK MUST BE PROVIDED FOR PEDESTRIANS WITH A MINIMUM WIDTH OF 42 INCHES.
- * SNOW REMOVAL MUST INCLUDE CLEARING SNOW FROM ALL CURB CUTS, INTERSECTIONS, CROSS-WALKS, HANDICAPPED RAMPS AND SIDEWALK LOCATIONS.
- * ANY RESIDENTIAL UNIT CONTAINING MORE THAN SIX RESIDENTIAL UNITS IS CONSIDERED COMMERCIAL PROPERTY.
- * VIOLATORS WILL BE SUBJECT TO A \$50 FINE FOR EACH DAY VIOLATIONS EXIST.

HOMEOWNERS AND RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY OWNERS

- * SNOW MUST BE REMOVED BETWEEN SUNRISE AND SUNSET, WITHIN 10 HOURS AFTER SNOW HAS STOPPED FALLING.
- * A CLEAR, FULL, PAVED PATH THE WIDTH OF THE SIDEWALK MUST BE PROVIDED FOR PEDESTRIANS WITH A MINIMUM WIDTH OF 42 INCHES.
- * SNOW REMOVAL MUST INCLUDE CLEARING SNOW FROM ALL CURB CUTS, INTERSECTIONS, CROSS-WALKS, HANDICAPPED RAMPS AND SIDEWALK LOCATIONS.
- * VIOLATORS WILL BE SUBJECT TO A \$50 FINE FOR EACH DAY VIOLATIONS EXIST.

The depositing or dumping of snow from private property and sidewalks into city streets is prohibited. Violators are subject to a \$100.00 fine.



The Parking Department, the Police Department, the Department of Public Works and the Inspectional Services Department of the City of Lynn are the authorities responsible for enforcement.
