Answers to your questions

If your trash was missed contact the DPW from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at 781-268-8000 x10. Do not place any of the following in your trash: non-empty aerosol cans, appliances, automotive batteries, chemical containers, construction debris, leaf and yard waste, flat-screen TVs or CRT monitors. For bulky materials, damaged carts or any additional trash or recycle containers for lease, contact Waste Management at 1-800-972-4545. Compost bins are available at the DPW for \$50.

Helpful hints

- ▲ For containers to be recycled, please rinse, and remove corks, rings and wraps and flatten all cardboard.
- ▲ Trash overflow bags (purple) vendor list available at cityofflynn.net.
- ▲ Items for waste collection or donations for pick-up cannot be placed upon the ground.
- ▲ Street sweeping will be held in the spring and fall. Check cityofflynn.net for schedule and more information.
- ▲ Snow emergency and removal information can be found on cityofflynn.net
- ▲ Needles must be in a rigid container. Return to City Hall, 1st floor. No loose needles.
- ▲ For furniture to be picked up curbside by Waste Management, the cost will be \$22.50 per item. Residents must call Waste Management at 1-800-972-4545.

What can I put in the recycle cart?

Glass bottles and jars

Note: Keep recyclables clean and dry. Do not bag recyclables.

What can't I put in the recycle cart?

The DPW office, located at 250 Commercial St., is open Monday, Wednesday and Thursday, 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.; Tuesday, 8:30 a.m. to 8 p.m.; and Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

The following services are for Lynn residents only. ID required.

Computer monitors, TVs, propane tanks

Computer monitors, TVs and propane tanks can be dropped off at 250 Commercial St. Monday through Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. There is a \$25 charge for monitors and TVs, \$5 for propane tanks.

Leaf and yard waste

Leaf and yard waste may be dropped off every Saturday from April to December at the DPW from 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. You may place yard waste curb-side on your regular trash day by 7:00 a.m., the weeks of 9/24/18, 10/22/18, 10/29/18, 11/5/18, 11/12/18, 11/19/18, 11/26/18, 1/7/19 4/8/19 and 5/20/19. Leaves, grass and other materials should be placed in barrels or paper leaf bags.

Dumpster Days

The DPW will hold Dumpster Days for large

items and fluorescent light bulbs at 250 Commercial St. on 7/14/18, 9/15/18 and 5/4/19 from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m. TVs, computer monitors and propane tanks will be accepted (\$25 for TVs/monitors, \$5 for propane tanks). No appliances, construction material or wood.

Hazardous Waste

Hazardous waste may be dropped off at 250 Commercial St., on 10/20/18 and 5/18/19 from 8 a.m. to noon. Payment required.

Christmas tree pickup

Christmas tree pickup will be Jan. 7-11, 2019.

Snow Emergency

During the winter months, Snow Emergency parking bans may be announced through various communication outlets and indicated by the blue lights around the city. All cars must be moved off the street during parking bans, or will be subject to fines and towing.

Trash and recyclables must be placed curbside no later than 7 a.m. and no earlier than 5 p.m. on the previous day.
