The City of Lynn will award approximately \$623,055 subject to final appropriation from the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) program of the U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). These funds will be allocated for FY 2022-2023 to eligible sub-recipients that provide housing and related services to residents and families within Essex County in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Lynn, as the sub-recipient of the City of Cambridge, will administer this program through The Lynn Housing Authority & Neighborhood Development (LHAND). The HOPWA program addresses the specific needs of low-income persons medically diagnosed with HIV/AIDS and their families. HOPWA funds may be used for a wide range of housing, social services, program planning and development costs within Essex County.
