IN THE YEAR TWO THOUSAND SEVEN AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE
RELATIVE TO SHOPPING CARTS AND SHOPPING CARRIAGES IN THE OF LYNN

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Lynn and by the authority of the same as follows, to wit-

SECTION 1. All shopping carts and shopping carriages owned by any person or entity in the City of Lynn shall have the telephone number of the owner printed clearly on the handle.

SECTION 2. An owner of a shopping cart or a shopping carriage shall retrieve said shopping carts and shopping carriages within twenty-four (24) of being notified by the Department of Inspectional Services that the shopping cart and shopping carriage is located off- premises.

SECTION 3. Any violation the provisions of Section 1:00 of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars. Any violation of Section 2 shall be punishable by a fine of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars per shopping cart or shopping carriage.

SECTION 4. The Lynn Police Department shall be the enforcing authority of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. All Ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect thirty-one (31) days after its final approval as adopted and advertised

IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED NINETY-SIX AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO
THE THEFT OF SHOPPING CARTS IN THE CITY OF LYNN

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Lynn and by the authority of the same as follows, to wit:-

SECTION 1. An Ordinance relative to the theft of shopping carts in the City of Lynn is hereby established, and said ordinance shall provide as follows. It shall be unlawful for any person to remove from the premises of a supermarket/grocery store, a shopping cart owned by said store.

SECTION 2. Any person caught in the possession of such a grocery cart, off the premises of such a store, shall be punished by a fine of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and shall perform ten (10) hours of community service at the discretion of a court of competent jurisdiction.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect thirty-one (31) days after its final approval as adopted and advertised.
