NEW BUSINESS

1. Review and vote to approve the new application for use of the Common and Harbor Park as well as the application for Lynn Woods
2. The Lynn Recognition Committee would like to request the pavilion at Harbor Park be dedicated to Mr. Abney Darby
3. Joel Machado is requesting use of McManus Field on March 28th and 29th to host the New England Youth Tackle Football Jamboree.
4. Jeremy Mitchell with Gather Health Primary Care for Seniors is requesting to use the Common on May 26th or 27th from 11am to 3pm to host a free senior community event open to the public with live music, free giveaways and complementary snacks and water.
5. St Mary's Church will be using the Common for 3 separate but similar events. The Common will be used as a display area at the end of a procession from the church. A Special Event Permit has been approved for all 3 events with all interested parties notified. The first event is the annual Living Station display on Friday, April 3rd followed by the AdoFaith display on Saturday, April 11th and finally the Corpus Christi Procession on Sunday, June 7th. All events are between 1pm and 3pm.
6. Todd Bacon with the Gowdy Park Association will be using Gowdy Park for the annual 4th of July celebration.
7. Johnson Mao will be hosting the annual Khmer New Year Festival in the Common Saturday April 25th 2026. All special event permits have been received.
