NUMBER OF SIGNATURES NEEDED FOR THE OFFICE OF:

United States Senator – 10,000 signatures United States Representative in Congress – 2,000 signatures
Governor / Lieutenant Governor – 10,000 signatures Secretary of the Commonwealth – 5,000 signatures
Attorney General – 5,000 signatures State Treasurer – 5,000 signatures State Auditor – 5,000 signatures
Governor’s Councilor – 1,000 signature State Senator – 300 signatures State Representative – 150 signatures
**Candidates should collect 20% over the amount needed, to cover for non-voters.*
