A RESOLUTION THAT THE CITY OF LYNN FILE AND ACCEPT GRANTS WITH AND FROM THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS FOR THE PARKLAND ACQUISITIONS AND RENOVATIONS FOR COMMUNITIES PROGRAM FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO LYNN COMMONS HISTORIC FOUNTAIN PLAZA.

Whereas: Lynn Commons is a treasured community wide asset and the improvements to this recreational area are a City priority as evidenced by the most recent Open Space and Recreation Plan; and

Whereas: Lynn Commons is dedicated to park and recreation purposes under M.G.L. Chapter 45, Section 3; and

Whereas: Lynn Commons' ultimate restoration is guided in principle by both user and neighborhood requests, the City's Open Space and Recreation Plan, and the Lynn Common Master Plan.
One of the Common focal points, the Historic Fountain Plaza, is the subject of this grant and funds sought through this application. The fountain is currently inoperable and it and the plaza have fallen into disrepair. Through this grant application and the allocation of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, the City of Lynn hopes to bring the fountain back online and to renovate

- the plaza to further establish the concept of place that is the Lynn Commons and to diversify the park's cultural landscape.
- Whereas: The overall costs and fiscal budget constraints prevented the City from proceeding forward with the implementation of this project; and
- Whereas: The project was viewed as a series of phases to be implemented over time, by priority, as fiscal resources become available, with intention of securing grant funding, when and if available, to assist in this effort; and
- Whereas: The Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs (EOEEA) is offering reimbursable grants to cities and towns to support the preservation and restoration of urban parks through the Parkland Acquisitions and Renovations for Communities grant program (301CMR 5.00); and
- Whereas: This phase of the Lynn Commons Historic Fountain Plaza will cost a total of \$500,000 and the city has allocated \$500,000 in funds to secure a PARC Grant award of \$350,000 for the design and construction of improvements to Lynn Commons Historic Fountain Plaza.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

1. That the mayor be and is hereby authorized to file and accept grants from the Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs.
2. That the mayor be and is hereby authorized to take such actions as are necessary to carry out the terms, purposes and conditions of this grant to be administered by the Office of Economic and Community Development.
3. That this resolution shall take effect upon passage.
